AUGUST 27-30, 2009

GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

1. Entries will be accepted on Thursday, August 27th from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon at the Home Economics Show Exhibit area.

Entries in this Show are limited to RESIDENTS of KAUAI COUNTY. There will be TWO DIVISIONS:

JUNIOR - 17 years & below SENIOR – 18 years and older

2. ALL entries must be made by the EXHIBITOR and exhibited for the FIRST TIME at the Kauai County Farm Bureau Fair. The Committee reserves the right to refuse commercial and previously exhibited items. In addition, the Committee reserves the right to “group” items of the same design. For example, potholders with the same design, varying only in color would be grouped as one item. An individual may enter no more than ONE item in each GROUP.
3. Entries for both Junior and Senior Divisions **MUST** be properly entered. Official Display Tags will be available at the Home Show exhibit area. Entry Display Tags may be picked up in advance at the University of Hawaii Cooperative Extension Service Office, State Office Building, Room 210, Lihue (274-3471) or at the Neighborhood Centers and Public Libraries.
4. Judging will be by the Danish system. Therefore, there may be no ribbon awarded or there may be more than one blue, red or white ribbon given for each GROUP within each CLASS. Decisions of the judges are final. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

*Best in Show-\$50 Blue-\$10 Red-\$7 White-\$5 HM - Ribbon

*Best in Show--up to EIGHT ribbons may be awarded, one in each of the following Classes: CLOTHING, NEEDLEWORK, ARTS & CRAFTS; and for the SPECIAL CONTESTS featuring TARO, CHOCOLATE COOKIES, APRONS, LEGOS, & RECYCLED ARTS & CRAFT.

**Names of Best in Show winners will be posted.

5. All display items, ribbons and cash prizes MUST BE PICKED UP BETWEEN 2 -4 p.m. on SUNDAY, AUGUST 30st. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ENTRY RECEIPT to claim your prize. All unclaimed non-perishable items may be picked at the UH Extension Office.

A special contest using TARO OR POI in the recipe will be held this year.

Entries requiring refrigeration will not be accepted.

1. Each entry in each group must have the required number of items and be presented in a **disposable** covered container; i.e. sealable plastic bag or plastic covered container. **Do not cover in plastic wrap or foil.**
2. **RECIPE must** accompany the entry. All entries and recipes become the property of Kauai County Farm Bureau and may be used by KCFB in any and all media now known or hereafter developed for non-commercial and commercial purposes alike. Original recipes & entries submitted become the property of KCFB and will not be returned.
3. There will be only one division; no distinction between Junior and Senior.
4. Judging will be by the Danish System. (See page 1, item 4).

CLASS V: *SPECIAL BAKING CONTEST—CHOCOLATE COOKIES*

A baking contest featuring CHOCOLATE in the recipe will be held this year.

GROUPS: 1. DROP OR SHAPED COOKIES 2. BARS OR BROWNIES

1. An entry consists of EIGHT COOKIES or BROWNIES.
2. Each entry must be presented in a **disposable** covered container (i.e. sealable plastic bag or clear plastic covered container). **Do not cover in plastic wrap or foil.**
3. **RECIPE must** accompany the entry. All entries and recipes become the property of the Kauai County Farm Bureau and may be used by KCFB in any and all media now known or hereafter developed for non-commercial and commercial purposes alike. Original recipes and entries submitted become the property of KCFB and will not be returned.

4. There will be only one division (no distinction between Junior and Senior).
5. Judging will be by the Danish System and prizes will be awarded accordingly. (See page 1, Item #4)

CLASS VI & VII: SPECIAL CRAFT CONTESTS

There will be TWO special craft contests this year.

CLASS VI: APRONS

CLASS VII: RECYCLED ART & CRAFTS

1. All entries must be a sewn or hand-crafted creation. No store bought items will be accepted.
2. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
3. There will be only one division; no Junior and Senior.
4. These are two separate contests; you may enter one item in each contest.
5. Judging will be by the Danish system (see page 1, item #4).

CLASS VIII: SPECIAL CONTEST FOR JUNIORS

A special contest for JUNIORS will be held this year.

1. Juniors are asked to create an ORIGINAL item using LEGOS.
2. No kits allowed.
3. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
4. Judging will be by the Danish system (see page 1, item #4).
